1-17 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to the designation of the portion of United States Highway
 1-20 54 in El Paso County as the Korean War Veterans Memorial Highway.

1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 225, Transportation Code,
 1-23 is amended by adding Section 225.190 to read as follows:

1-24 Sec. 225.190. KOREAN WAR VETERANS MEMORIAL HIGHWAY. (a)
 1-25 The portion of United States Highway 54 in El Paso County between
 1-26 its intersection with State Highway Loop 375 and the New Mexico
 1-27 state border is designated as the Korean War Veterans Memorial
 1-28 Highway. This designation is in addition to any other designation.

1-29 (b) Subject to Section 225.021(c), the department shall:

1-30 (1) design and construct markers indicating the
 1-31 designation as the Korean War Veterans Memorial Highway and any
 1-32 other appropriate information; and

1-33 (2) erect a marker at each end of the highway and at
 1-34 appropriate intermediate sites along the highway.

1-35 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
