1-17 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION

1-18 proposing a constitutional amendment prohibiting the unsolicited  
 1-19 distribution of an application form for an absentee ballot.

1-20 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-21 SECTION 1. Section 2, Article VI, Texas Constitution, is  
 1-22 amended by adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:

1-23 (d) An officer or employee of this state or of a political  
 1-24 subdivision of this state may not distribute an official  
 1-25 application form for an absentee ballot to a person unless the  
 1-26 person has requested the distribution.

1-27 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be  
 1-28 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 2, 2021.  
 1-29 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the  
 1-30 proposition: "The constitutional amendment prohibiting the  
 1-31 unsolicited distribution of an application form for an absentee  
 1-32 ballot."
