1-25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-26 SECTION 1. Section 86.015(b), Election Code, is amended to
 1-27 read as follows:

1-28 (b) The online tool developed or provided under Subsection
 1-29 (a) must require the voter to provide, before permitting the voter
 1-30 to access information described by that subsection:

1-31 (1) the voter's name and date of birth [~~registration~~
 1-32 ~~address~~] and the last four digits of the voter's social security
 1-33 number; and

1-34 (2) the voter's:
 1-35 (A) driver's license number; or
 1-36 (B) personal identification card number issued
 1-37 by the Department of Public Safety.

1-38 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.

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
