1-19 relating to the definition of a commercial fleet.  
 1-20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:  
 1-21 SECTION 1. Section [502.001\(6\)](#), Transportation Code, is  
 1-22 amended to read as follows:  
 1-23 (6) "Commercial fleet" means a group of at least 12  
 1-24 [~~25~~] nonapportioned motor vehicles, semitrailers, or trailers  
 1-25 owned, operated, or leased by a corporation, limited or general  
 1-26 partnership, limited liability company, or other business entity  
 1-27 and used for the business purposes of that entity.  
 1-28 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
