relating to the creation of the criminal offense of unlawful disclosure of residence address or telephone number. 1-17 1**-**18 1-19

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-20 SECTION 1. Chapter 42, Penal Code, is amended by adding 1-21 Section 42.074 to read as follows:

Sec. 42.074. UNLAWFUL DISCLOSURE OF RESIDENCE ADDRESS OR ONE NUMBER. (a) A person commits an offense if the person 1-22 1-23 TELEPHONE NUMBER. posts on a publicly accessible website the residence address or 1-24 1-25 telephone number of an individual with the intent to cause harm or a threat of harm to the individual or a member of the individual 1-26 S family or household. 1-27

1-28 (b) An offense under this section is a Class B misdemeanor, except that the offense is a Class A misdemeanor if the offense 1-29 1-30 results in the bodily injury of:

1-31 (1) the individual whose residence address or telephone number was posted on a publicly accessible website; or (2) a member of the individual's family or household 1-32 1 - 33

(c) This section does not apply to a public servant who 1-34 posted information described by Subsection (a) to a publicly 1-35 accessible website in the performance of the public servant's duties as required by or in accordance with state or federal law. (d) If conduct that constitutes an offense under this 1-36 1-37 1-38

section also constitutes an offense under Section 36.06(a-1), the 1-39 actor may be prosecuted under either section but not both. 1-40 1-41 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
