1-18 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-19 AN ACT

1-20 relating to the ability of a local authority to designate school
 1-21 crossing zones and school crosswalks at high school campuses
 1-22 located in certain municipalities.

1-23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-24 SECTION 1. Section 542.203, Transportation Code, is amended
 1-25 by adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:

1-26 (d) A local authority may not adopt or enforce an order,
 1-27 ordinance, regulation, or other measure that prohibits or precludes
 1-28 the designation of a school crossing zone or school crosswalk at a
 1-29 high school campus that is located in a municipality with a
 1-30 population of two million or more.

1-31 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
