

(b) A person other than the voter who assists a voter by depositing the carrier envelope in the mail or with a common or contract carrier or who obtains the carrier envelope for that purpose must provide the person's signature, printed name, and residence address on the reverse side of the envelope. <u>The person</u> must sign the envelope using ink on paper. An electronic signature or photocopied signature is not permitted.
