BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: SECTION 1. Chapter 197, Acts of the 59th Legislature, Regular Session, 1965, is amended by adding Section 22A to read as follows: <u>Sec. 22A. FEES. (a) The Board may impose:</u> (1) a combined production and export fee on water exported from the District in an amount not to exceed 20 cents for each thousand gallons of water exported from the District; and (2) other fees as authorized by Chapter 36, Water <u>Code.</u> (b) A fee collected under Subsection (a)(1) of this section may only be used: (1) to maintain the operability of wells significantly affected by groundwater export projects; and (2) as authorized by Section 36.122(1), Water Code.
