1-18 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-19 AN ACT

1-20 relating to the workforce development evaluation system
 1-21 administered by the Texas Workforce Commission, including the
 1-22 establishment of a workforce development career education and
 1-23 training evaluation pilot program.

1-24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-25 SECTION 1. Section 302.001, Labor Code, is amended by
 1-26 amending Subdivision (1) and adding Subdivision (1-a) to read as
 1-27 follows:

1-28 (1) "Career education and training program" has the
 1-29 meaning assigned by Section 2308A.001, Government Code.

1-30 (1-a) "Director" means the director of the division.

1-31 SECTION 2. Subchapter A, Chapter 302, Labor Code, is
 1-32 amended by adding Section 302.0201 to read as follows:

1-33 Sec. 302.0201. WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT CAREER EDUCATION AND
 1-34 TRAINING EVALUATION PILOT PROGRAM. (a) The commission shall
 1-35 establish and administer a pilot program in the Borderplex
 1-36 workforce development area under which the local workforce
 1-37 development board serving that area is required to collect and
 1-38 evaluate cross-sectional data and longitudinal supplemental data
 1-39 regarding career education and training programs administered in
 1-40 that area for the purposes of identifying:

1-41 (1) successful program components; and

1-42 (2) any gaps in data used to follow up on career
 1-43 education and training program participants following program
 1-44 completion maintained by the commission, the Texas Education
 1-45 Agency, or the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board under the
 1-46 Tri-Agency Workforce Initiative established under Chapter 2308A,
 1-47 Government Code.

1-48 (b) Under the pilot program, the commission shall ensure
 1-49 that the local workforce development board serving the workforce
 1-50 development area maintains the following information for each
 1-51 career education and training program participant following
 1-52 program completion, disaggregated by race, ethnicity, sex, income,
 1-53 and location:

1-54 (1) the evaluation data described by Section
 1-55 302.082(b); and

1-56 (2) data regarding the attainment of employment paying
 1-57 a self-sufficient wage, as determined under Section 2308A.012,
 1-58 Government Code.

1-59 (c) On completion of the pilot program, the local workforce
 1-60 development board serving the workforce development area, in
 1-61 coordination with the commission, shall issue an analysis, by

2-1 occupation and by provider, of the job placement performance of
2-2 each career education and training program. The analysis must
2-3 include:

2-4 (1) an analysis of the attainment of employment paying
2-5 a self-sufficient wage, as determined under Section 2308A.012,
2-6 Government Code, following program completion; and

2-7 (2) detailed information on the services provided with
2-8 each offered program.

2-9 (d) The commission may share individual-level outcome
2-10 information resulting from the pilot program with state agencies
2-11 represented on the council through secure means that may be
2-12 accessed only by authorized employees of those agencies.

2-13 (e) Not later than December 1, 2028, the commission shall
2-14 submit to the legislature a written report on the results of the
2-15 pilot program. The report must include the commission's
2-16 recommendation on whether the pilot program should be continued on
2-17 a statewide basis.

2-18 (f) This section expires September 1, 2029.

2-19 SECTION 3. Section 302.082, Labor Code, is amended by
2-20 amending Subsections (b) and (c) and adding Subsection (d) to read
2-21 as follows:

2-22 (b) Evaluation data in the system must include the following
2-23 information disaggregated by race, ethnicity, sex, income, and
2-24 location:

2-25 (1) placement rates;

2-26 (2) wages paid;

2-27 (3) retention in employment statistics;

2-28 (4) the number of education and training-related
2-29 placements; and

2-30 (5) other appropriate factors, including public
2-31 welfare dependency and the pursuit of additional education.

2-32 (c) The commission may develop a method for collecting
2-33 occupational information to supplement wage record information
2-34 collected by the commission under Section 204.0025. The commission
2-35 may request employers, providers, and other appropriate sources to
2-36 provide placement, employment, and earnings information to the
2-37 commission.

2-38 (d) The commission shall ensure that:

2-39 (1) the system includes with the evaluation data a
2-40 hyperlink to an Internet website where self-sufficient wage data as
2-41 determined under Section 2308A.012, Government Code, is posted; and

2-42 (2) following any modernization of the evaluation
2-43 system by the commission on or after September 1, 2023, the
2-44 evaluation data in the system includes a comparison of
2-45 self-sufficient wage data with program earnings outcomes at the
2-46 first, third, and fifth anniversary of the date of program
2-47 completion.

2-48 SECTION 4. Section 302.083, Labor Code, is amended by
2-49 adding Subsection (a-1) to read as follows:

2-50 (a-1) Following any modernization of the evaluation system
2-51 by the commission on or after September 1, 2023, an analysis issued
2-52 under Subsection (a) must include:

2-53 (1) an analysis regarding the attainment of employment
2-54 paying a self-sufficient wage, as determined under Section
2-55 2308A.012, Government Code, following completion of a career
2-56 education and training program; and

2-57 (2) detailed information on the services provided with
2-58 each offered program.

2-59 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
