## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1-19 relating to the issuance of specialty license plates to certain 1-20 professional sports teams. 1-21

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 1-23 SECTION 1. Section 504.614(a), Transportation Code, is amended to read as follows:

1-24 (a) The department may issue specialty license plates that 1-25 include the name and insignia of a professional sports team located 1-26 in this state. The department shall design the license plates in 1-27 1-28 consultation with the professional sports team and may enter a trademark license with the professional sports team or its league 1-29 to implement this section. A license plate may be issued under this 1-30 section only for a professional sports team that:
