BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Section 96.01, Education Code, is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 96.01. SUL ROSS STATE UNIVERSITY. Sul Ross State University is a coeducational institution of higher education located in the city of Alpine, with an [upper-level] educational center known as Sul Ross State University Rio Grande College operated in the cities of Del Rio, Eagle Pass, and Uvalde. The university is under the management and control of the Board of Regents, Texas State University System.

SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning January 1, 2026.
SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 1-37 1-38 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 1-39 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 1-40 1-41 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
