 1-19 AN ACT

1-20 relating to the designation of a portion of Interstate Highway 35 in
 1-21 Williamson County as the Officer Charles Whites Memorial Highway.

1-22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-23 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 225, Transportation Code,
 1-24 is amended by adding Section 225.217 to read as follows:

1-25 Sec. 225.217. OFFICER CHARLES WHITES MEMORIAL HIGHWAY. (a)
 1-26 The portion of Interstate Highway 35 in Williamson County between
 1-27 its intersection with State Highway 45 and its intersection with
 1-28 Westinghouse Road is designated as the Officer Charles Whites
 1-29 Memorial Highway. The designation is in addition to any other
 1-30 designation.

1-31 (b) Subject to Section 225.021(c), the department shall:

1-32 (1) design and construct markers indicating the
 1-33 designation as the Officer Charles Whites Memorial Highway and any
 1-34 other appropriate information; and

1-35 (2) erect a marker at each end of the highway and at
 1-36 appropriate intermediate sites along the highway.

1-37 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
