1-21 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
 1-22 AN ACT

1-23 relating to the establishment of a new open-enrollment charter  
 1-24 school campus by certain charter holders and to the expansion of an  
 1-25 open-enrollment charter school.

1-26 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-27 SECTION 1. Section 12.101(b-10), Education Code, is amended  
 1-28 to read as follows:

1-29 (b-10) The commissioner by rule shall allow a charter holder  
 1-30 to provide written notice of the establishment of a new  
 1-31 open-enrollment charter school campus under Subsection (b-4)(2) up  
 1-32 to 36 [~~18~~] months before the date on which the campus is anticipated  
 1-33 to open. Notice provided to the commissioner under this section  
 1-34 does not obligate the charter holder to open a new campus.

1-35 SECTION 2. Section 12.114(d), Education Code, is amended to  
 1-36 read as follows:

1-37 (d) A charter holder may submit a request for approval for  
 1-38 an expansion amendment up to 36 [~~18~~] months before the date on which  
 1-39 the expansion will be effective. A request for approval of an  
 1-40 expansion amendment does not obligate the charter holder to  
 1-41 complete the proposed expansion.

1-42 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.

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
