## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

relating to the adoption of physical fitness programs and standards 1-17 -1**-**18 for law enforcement officers employed by the office of the attorney 1-19 general.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-21 SECTION 1. Section 614.171(1), Government Code, is amended to read as follows:

1-22 1-23 (1) "Law enforcement agency" means the Department of Safety, 1-24 Texas Alcoholic Beverage Commission, Texas Public 1-25 Department of Criminal Justice, [<del>and</del>] Parks and Wildlife 1-26

Department, and the office of the attorney general. SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 1-27 1-28 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 1-29 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 1-30 1-31 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
