1-15 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-16 AN ACT

1-17 relating to the adoption of physical fitness programs and standards
1-18 for law enforcement officers employed by the office of the attorney
1-19 general.

1-20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-21 SECTION 1. Section 614.171(1), Government Code, is amended
1-22 to read as follows:

1-23 (1) "Law enforcement agency" means the Department of
1-24 Public Safety, Texas Alcoholic Beverage Commission, Texas
1-25 Department of Criminal Justice, ~~and~~ Parks and Wildlife
1-26 Department, and the office of the attorney general.

1-27 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-28 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-29 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-30 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-31 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
