1-29 relating to the determination of the sufficient balance of the 1-30 economic stabilization fund for the purpose of allocating general 1-31 revenue to that fund and the state highway fund. 1-32

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-33 SECTION 1. Section 316.092(b), Government Code, is amended 1-34 to read as follows: 1-35

(b) This section expires December 31, 2042 [2034]. SECTION 2. Sections 316.093(c) and (d), Government Code, 1-36 1-37 are amended to read as follows:

1-38 (c) For the purposes of Section 49-g(c-2), Article III, Texas Constitution, the comptroller shall adjust the allocation provided by Section 49-g(c-1) of that article of amounts to be transferred to the fund and to the state highway fund under Section 1-39 1-40 1-41 1-42 49-g(c) of that article in a state fiscal year beginning on or after 1-43 September 1, 2043 [2035], so that the total of those amounts is 1-44 transferred to the economic stabilization fund, except that the 1-45 comptroller shall reduce a transfer made under this subsection as 1-46 necessary to prevent the amount in the fund from exceeding the limit in effect for that biennium under Section 49-g(g) of that article. 1-47

1-48 (d) Subsections (a) and (b) and this subsection expire 1-49 December 31, 2042 [2034].
