1-20 relating to the use of hotel occupancy tax revenue by certain
 1-21 municipalities.

1-22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-23 SECTION 1. Section 351.101, Tax Code, is amended by adding
 1-24 Subsection (t) to read as follows:

1-25 (t) In addition to other authorized uses, a municipality
 1-26 that is bisected by the Guadalupe River and is the county seat of a
 1-27 county with a population of 170,000 or more may use revenue from the
 1-28 municipal hotel occupancy tax for the promotion of tourism by the
 1-29 enhancement and upgrading of an existing sports facility or field
 1-30 as specified by Subsection (a)(7), provided that the requirements
 1-31 of Subsections (a)(7)(A) and (C) and Section 351.1076 are met.

1-32 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.

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
