1-19 relating to a requirement that the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality obtain or develop updated water availability 1-20 models for certain river basins. 1-21

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 1-23 SECTION 1. Section 16.012, Water Code, is amended by adding Subsection (h-2) to read as follows: 1-24

1-25	(h-2) Not later than December 1, 2026, the commission shall
1-26	obtain or develop updated water availability models for the
1-27	Guadalupe, Lavaca, Nueces, San Antonio, San Jacinto, and Trinity
	River basins. The commission may collect data from all
1-29	jurisdictions that allocate the waters of the rivers, including
1-30	jurisdictions outside this state. This subsection expires
1-31	September 1, 2027.

SECTION 2. The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality is 1-32 required to implement a provision of this Act only if the legislature appropriates money specifically for that purpose. If 1-33 1-34 1-35 the legislature does not appropriate money specifically for that 1-36 purpose, the commission may, but is not required to, implement a 1-37 provision of this Act using other appropriations available for that 1-38 purpose. SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
