BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Sections 451.001(1) and (3), Occupations Code, are amended to read as follows:

- (1) "Athletic injury" means an injury sustained by a person as a result of <u>physical activity or exercise or</u> the person's participation in an organized sport or sport-related exercise or activity, including interscholastic, intercollegiate, intramural, recreational, semiprofessional, professional and sports activities.
- "Athletic training" means the form of health care (3) that includes <u>principles</u> and <u>methods</u> for <u>managing</u> and <u>treating</u> athletic injuries for athletic individuals in good general health [the practice of preventing, recognizing, assessing, managing, treating, disposing of, and reconditioning athletic injuries] under the direction of a physician licensed in this state or another qualified, licensed health professional who is authorized to refer for health care services within the scope of the person's license, and consists of:
- (A) managing the risk of an athletic injury or
