1-21 relating to certain construction liability claims concerning
 1-22 public buildings and public works.

1-23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-24 SECTION 1. Chapter 2272, Government Code, is amended by
 1-25 adding Section 2272.0025 to read as follows:

1-26 Sec. 2272.0025. WAIVER PROHIBITED. This chapter may not be
 1-27 waived. A purported waiver of this chapter in violation of this
 1-28 section is void.

1-29 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
 1-30 to a cause of action that accrues on or after the effective date of
 1-31 this Act under a contract entered into on or after the effective
 1-32 date of this Act. A cause of action that accrued before the
 1-33 effective date of this Act or that accrues on or after the effective
 1-34 date of this Act under a contract entered into before the effective
 1-35 date of this Act is governed by the law as it existed immediately
 1-36 before the effective date of this Act, and that law is continued in
 1-37 effect for that purpose.

1-38 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
