A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

relating to the prosecution of the criminal offenses of aggravated kidnapping, kidnapping, and interference with child custody.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

This Act may be cited as Bianca's Law.

SECTION 2. Article 12.01, Code of Criminal Procedure, is amended to read as follows:

Art. 12.01. FELONIES. Except as provided in Article 12.03, felony indictments may be presented within these limits, and not afterward:

SECTION 3. Section 25.03, Penal Code, is amended by adding Subsection (e) to read as follows:

(e) If conduct that constitutes an offense under Subsection (a)(3) also constitutes an offense under Section 20.03, the actor

may be prosecuted only under Section 20.03.

SECTION 4. Article 12.01, Code of Criminal Procedure, as amended by this Act, does not apply to the prosecution of an offense if that prosecution becomes barred by limitation before the effective date of this Act. The prosecution of the offense remains barred as if this Act had not taken effect.

SECTION 5. Section 25.03(e), Penal Code, as added by this Act, applies only to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act. An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed, and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred before that date.

SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
