1-17 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to the classification of transportation districts by the
1-20 Texas Transportation Commission.

1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. Section 201.105, Transportation Code, is amended
1-23 by adding Subsection (h) to read as follows:

1-24 (h) The commission by rule shall prescribe criteria for the
1-25 classification of each district as metropolitan, urban, or rural.
1-26 The rules must classify a district with a population of more than
1-27 one million as metropolitan.

1-28 SECTION 2. As soon as practicable after the effective date
1-29 of this Act, the Texas Transportation Commission shall adopt the
1-30 rules required by Section 201.105(h), Transportation Code, as added
1-31 by this Act.

1-32 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
