BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Section 437.351, Government Code, is amended by amending Subsection (d) and adding Subsection (e) to read as 1-20 1-21 1-22 1-23 follows:

(d) The legislature by concurrent resolution may direct the governor to award the Texas Legislative Medal of Honor to a service 1-24 member nominated by the nominating committee. The committee chairs serving on the nominating committee shall jointly prepare a 1-25 1-26 concurrent resolution directing the governor to award the medal to a service member nominated. The legislature may direct the medal to 1-27 1-28 1-29 be awarded only during a regular session and may not, during a regular session, direct the medal to be awarded to more than: 1-30

(1) one service member for service in the state or federal military forces during the period beginning after 1835 but before <u>September 11, 2001</u> [1956]; and (2) one service member for service in the state or 1-31 1-32 1-33

1-34 federal military forces on or after <u>September 11, 2001</u> [1955]. 1-35
