1-26 SECTION 2. Section 27.202, Water Code, is amended to read as 1-27 follows:

(a) The commission has exclusive jurisdiction over the regulation and permitting of 1-29 recharge injection wells, including recharge injection wells used for the injection of fluid oil and gas waste. (b) A recharge injection well may not be used for the injection of fluid oil and gas waste unless the waste has been 1-30 1-31
