SECTION 2. Section 43.26, Penal Code, bу is amended amending Subsection (d) and adding Subsection (d-1) to read as follows:

(d)

An offense under Subsection (a) is: (1) a felony of the third degree if the person visual material that contains fewer than 100 visual <u>poss</u>esses depictions of a child as described by Subsection (a)(1);

(2) [, except that the offense is: [(1)] a felony of the second degree if [it is shown on the offense that] the person possesses visual material that contains 100 or more visual depictions of a child as described by Subsection (a)(1) but fewer than 500 such depictions [has been convicted one time of an offense under that subsection];

(3) [and

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 $\overline{(2)}$ a felony of the first degree if [it is shown on thetrial of the offense that] the person possesses visual material that contains 500 or more visual depictions of a child as described by Subsection (a)(1); or

(4) a felony of the first degree punishable by imprisonment in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice for life or for any term of not more than 99 years or less than 25 years if it is shown on the trial of the offense that, at the time of the offense, the person was:

(A) an employee at a child-care facility or a residential child-care facility, as those terms are defined by Section 42.002, Human Resources Code;

(B) an employee at a residential treatment facility established under Section 221.056, Human Resources Code;

(C) an employee at a shelf serves youth and that receives state funds; or shelter or facility

(D) receiving state funds for the care of a child depicted by the visual material [has been previously convicted two

or more times of an offense under that subsection].

(d-1) If it is shown on the trial of an offense under Subsection (a) that the visual material depicted a child younger than 10 years of age at the time the image of the child was made or that the defendant has been previously convicted of an offense under that subsection:

(1) an offense described for purposes of punishment by Subsection (d)(1) or (2) is increased to the next higher category of offense; or

(2) the minimum term of confinement for an offense for purposes of punishment by Subsection (d)(3) is described

increased to 15 years.

SECTION 3. Article 12.01, Code of Criminal Procedure, as amended by this Act, does not apply to an offense if the prosecution of that offense becomes barred by limitation before the effective date of this Act. The prosecution of that offense remains barred as if this Act had not taken effect.

SECTION 4. Section 43.26, Penal Code, as amended by this Act, applies only to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act. An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed, and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred before that date.

SECTION 5. To the extent of any conflict, this Act prevails
