1-19 relating to the eligibility of a person employed by a school
 1-20 district as a teacher to serve on the appraisal review board of an
 1-21 appraisal district.

1-22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-23 SECTION 1. Section 6.412(c), Tax Code, is amended to read as
 1-24 follows:

1-25 (c) Except as otherwise provided by this subsection, a [A]
 1-26 person is ineligible to serve on the appraisal review board if the
 1-27 person is a member of the board of directors, [an] officer, or
 1-28 employee of the appraisal district, an employee of the comptroller,
 1-29 or a member of the governing body, officer, or employee of a taxing
 1-30 unit. A person employed by a school district as a teacher may serve
 1-31 on the appraisal review board.

1-32 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
