A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1-21 relating to requests to a municipality for production or 1-22 1-23 certification of a record in certain civil actions; authorizing a fee. 1-24

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Section 22.004, Civil Practice and Remedies Code, is amended by amending Subsections (a) and (b) and adding 1-25 1-26 1-27 1-28 Subsection (a-1) to read as follows:

Except as provided by Subsection (a-1), a [A] custodian (a) of a record who receives a request for production or certification 1-29 1-30 of a record under a subpoena, a request for production, or other 1-31 instrument issued under the authority of a tribunal that compels production or certification of a record is entitled to \$1 for production or certification of the record. If more than one record 1-32 1-33 is produced or certified, the custodian of the records is entitled 1-34 1-35 to only one fee under this section.

1-36 (a-1) A municipality that receives a request for production or certification of a record under a subpoena, a request for production, or other instrument in relation to a matter to which the 1-37 1-38 municipality is not a party and that is issued under the authority 1-39 of a tribunal that compels production or certification of a record 1-40 is entitled to impose a fee for production or certification of the record in the same amount and manner provided by Subchapter F, Chapter 552, Government Code, for a charge for providing a copy of 1-41 1-42 1-43 public information, as if the production or certification of the 1-44 1-45 record is the provision of a copy of public information under that chapter. 1-46

(b) A custodian of a record who produces or certifies a record under Subsection (a) or (a-1), but who is not required to 1-47 1-48 appear in court, is not entitled to a witness fee under Section 1-49 1-50 22.001.

SECTION 2. Section 22.004, Civil Practice and Remedies Code, as amended by this Act, applies only to a production or certification request issued on or after the effective date of this 1-51 1-52 1-53 Act. A production or certification request issued before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law as it existed 1-54 1-55 immediately before the effective date of this Act, and that law is continued in effect for that purpose. 1-56 1-57

1-58 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
