1-19 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-20 AN ACT

1-21 relating to the authority of a general-law municipality or county
 1-22 to regulate residential child detention facilities.

1-23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-24 SECTION 1. Chapter 250, Local Government Code, is amended
 1-25 by adding Section 250.014 to read as follows:

1-26 Sec. 250.014. REGULATION OF CERTAIN RESIDENTIAL CHILD
 1-27 DETENTION FACILITIES. (a) In this section, "residential child
 1-28 detention facility" means a private facility other than a facility
 1-29 licensed by this state that operates under a contract with the
 1-30 United States Immigration and Customs Enforcement, the United
 1-31 States Department of Health and Human Services, or another federal
 1-32 agency to provide 24-hour custody or care to unaccompanied
 1-33 immigrant or refugee children.

1-34 (b) This section applies only to a residential child
 1-35 detention facility.

1-36 (c) A general-law municipality or a county in the
 1-37 unincorporated area of the county may:

1-38 (1) designate an area in which a residential child
 1-39 detention facility may be located; and

1-40 (2) take other measures necessary to protect the
 1-41 health and safety of the individuals residing in a residential
 1-42 child detention facility.

1-43 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
 1-44 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
 1-45 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 1-46 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 1-47 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
