A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1-23 relating to establishing residency for purposes of admission into public schools. 1-24

1-25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 1-26 SECTION 1. Section 25.001(c-2), Education Code, is amended to read as follows:

1-27 1-28 (c-2) A person who establishes residency as provided by Subsection (c-1) shall provide to the school district proof of 1-29 1-30 residence in the district's attendance zone not later than the 90th 1-31 [10th] day after the arrival date specified in the order described by that subsection. For purposes of this subsection, "residence" includes residence in a military temporary lodging facility. SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2023-2024 1-32 1-33

1-34 1-35 school year.

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 1-36 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 1-37 1-38 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 1-39 Act takes effect September 1, 2023. 1-40
