1-19 relating to the titling, registration, and operation of an autocycle. 1-20 1-21

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 1-23 SECTION 1. Section 501.008(a), Transportation Code, is amended to read as follows: 1-24

(a) In this section, "autocycle" means a motor vehicle, 1-25 other than a tractor, that is:

1-26 designed to have when propelled not more than (1)1-27 three wheels on the ground;

1-28 equipped with seat belts and a steering mechanism (2) 1-29 [wheel]; 1-30

(3) equipped with seating that does not require the 1-31 operator to straddle or sit astride the seat; and

1-32 (4) manufactured and certified to comply with federal 1-33 safety requirements for a motorcycle.

1-34 SECTION 2. Section 502.005(a), Transportation Code, is 1-35 amended to read as follows:

1-36 "autocycle" means a motor vehicle, (a) In this section, 1-37 other than a tractor, that is:
