BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 552, Government Code, is amended by adding Section 552.163 to read as follows:

Sec. 552.163. EXCEPTION: CONFIDENTIALITY OF INFORMATION REGARDING FRAUD DETECTION AND DETERRENCE MEASURES AND COUNTERTERRORISM MEASURES. Information in the custody of a governmental body that relates to fraud detection and deterrence measures or counterterrorism measures is confidential and excepted

from the requirements of Section 552.021.
