1-19 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-20 AN ACT

1-21 relating to the use of certain weapons in or on the bed or bank of a
 1-22 navigable river or stream in certain counties.

1-23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-24 SECTION 1. The heading to Chapter 284, Parks and Wildlife
 1-25 Code, is amended to read as follows:

1-26 CHAPTER 284. CHILDRESS, COTTLE, DIMMIT, EDWARDS, FOARD, FRIO,
 1-27 HALL, KENEDY, LAMPASAS, LLANO, MAVERICK, MOTLEY, REAL, UVALDE, AND
 1-28 ZAVALA COUNTIES

1-29 SECTION 2. The heading to Section 284.001, Parks and
 1-30 Wildlife Code, is amended to read as follows:

1-31 Sec. 284.001. USE OF CERTAIN WEAPONS IN OR ON BED OR BANK OF
 1-32 NAVIGABLE RIVER OR STREAM [DISCHARGE OF FIREARM] PROHIBITED.

1-33 SECTION 3. Section 284.001(b), Parks and Wildlife Code, is
 1-34 amended to read as follows:

1-35 (b) This section applies only to a navigable river or stream
 1-36 located wholly or partly in Childress, Cottle, Dimmit, Edwards,
 1-37 Foard, Frio, Hall, Kennedy, Lampasas, Llano, Maverick, Motley, Real,
 1-38 Uvalde, or Zavala County.

1-39 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
