BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 1-23 SECTION 1. Section 843.337, Insurance Code, is amended by amending Subsections (b) and (c) and adding Subsection (c-1) to 1-24 read as follows:
