1-19 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-20 AN ACT

1-21 relating to the confidentiality of certain information collected by
 1-22 certain local governments and airport governing boards at a parking
 1-23 facility.

1-24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-25 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 22, Transportation Code,
 1-26 is amended by adding Section 22.028 to read as follows:

1-27 Sec. 22.028. CONFIDENTIALITY OF CERTAIN INFORMATION
 1-28 COLLECTED BY LOCAL GOVERNMENT. Personal identifying information
 1-29 collected by a local government is confidential and not subject to
 1-30 disclosure under Chapter 552, Government Code, if the information
 1-31 collected is in relation to a person's use of an airport parking
 1-32 facility that includes:

1-33 (1) the person's name, address, e-mail address, phone
 1-34 number, and zip code;

1-35 (2) the person's license plate number, toll tag
 1-36 number, and credit, debit, or other payment card number; or

1-37 (3) the dates the person's vehicle was parked at the
 1-38 facility, the date the person's vehicle exited the facility, and
 1-39 the amount the person paid to park in the facility.

1-40 SECTION 2. Section 22.091, Transportation Code, is amended
 1-41 to read as follows:

1-42 Sec. 22.091. CONFIDENTIALITY OF CERTAIN INFORMATION
 1-43 COLLECTED BY JOINT BOARD. Personal identifying information
 1-44 collected by a joint board for which the constituent agencies are
 1-45 populous home-rule municipalities is confidential and not subject
 1-46 to disclosure under Chapter 552, Government Code, if the
 1-47 information collected is in relation to:

1-48 (1) a commercial online payment system and includes a
 1-49 person's:

1-50 (A) [~~(1)~~] name, address, e-mail address, or
 1-51 phone number;

1-52 (B) [~~(2)~~] account number, password, payment
 1-53 transaction activity, toll or charge record, or credit, debit, or
 1-54 other payment card number; or

1-55 (C) [~~(3)~~] other personal financial information;
 1-56 or

1-57 (2) a person's use of an airport parking facility that
 1-58 includes:

1-59 (A) the person's name, address, e-mail address,
 1-60 phone number, and zip code;

2-1 (B) the person's license plate number, toll tag
2-2 number, and credit, debit, or other payment card number; or

2-3 (C) the dates the person's vehicle was parked at
2-4 the facility, the date the person's vehicle exited the facility,
2-5 and the amount the person paid to park in the facility.

2-6 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only
2-7 to a request for public information received by a governmental body
2-8 or an officer for public information on or after the effective date
2-9 of this Act.

2-10 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
