1-22 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-23 AN ACT

1-24 relating to requiring public schools to maintain physical copies of
 1-25 certain instructional materials.

1-26 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-27 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 31, Education Code, is
 1-28 amended by adding Section 31.107 to read as follows:

1-29 Sec. 31.107. REQUIRED PHYSICAL COPIES OF INSTRUCTIONAL
 1-30 MATERIALS. (a) This section applies only to instructional
 1-31 materials provided in a physical medium.

1-32 (b) The board of trustees of each school district and the
 1-33 governing body of each open-enrollment charter school shall, for
 1-34 each instructional material selected by the district or school for
 1-35 a subject in the foundation or enrichment curriculum:

1-36 (1) make available at least one physical copy of the
 1-37 instructional material in each classroom in which the instructional
 1-38 material is used;

1-39 (2) provide to each teacher at a district or school who
 1-40 uses the instructional material in teaching a course a physical
 1-41 copy of the teacher version of the instructional material, if
 1-42 available; and

1-43 (3) maintain in the school library at each district or
 1-44 school campus at which the instructional material is used a number
 1-45 of physical copies of the instructional material at least equal to
 1-46 five percent of the total number of students in the grade level in
 1-47 which the instructional material is used.

1-48 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2023-2024
 1-49 school year.

1-50 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
 1-51 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
 1-52 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 1-53 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 1-54 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
