1-21 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-22 AN ACT

1-23 relating to standards for certain electric vehicle charging
 1-24 stations.

1-25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
 1-26 SECTION 1. Subtitle A, Title 14, Occupations Code, is
 1-27 amended by adding Chapter 2311 to read as follows:

1-28 CHAPTER 2311. ELECTRIC VEHICLE CHARGING STATIONS
 1-29 Sec. 2311.001. ELECTRIC VEHICLE CHARGING STATION
 1-30 STANDARDS. (a) This section applies only to an electric vehicle
 1-31 charging station that is:

- 1-32 (1) installed after December 1, 2024;
- 1-33 (2) made available to the public; and
- 1-34 (3) not intended primarily for private use.

1-35 (b) The Texas Department of Licensing and Regulation, in
 1-36 consultation with the Texas Department of Transportation, shall
 1-37 adopt standards for electric vehicle charging stations that require
 1-38 the charging stations to be equipped with a standard electric
 1-39 vehicle charging connector or plug type that is widely compatible
 1-40 with as many electric vehicles as practicable.

1-41 SECTION 2. (a) Not later than December 1, 2024, the Texas
 1-42 Department of Licensing and Regulation shall adopt the standards
 1-43 required by Section 2311.001, Occupations Code, as added by this
 1-44 Act.

1-45 (b) An electric vehicle charging station installed in this
 1-46 state must be operated in compliance with the standards adopted
 1-47 under Chapter 2311, Occupations Code, as added by this Act, not
 1-48 later than January 1, 2030.

1-49 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
 1-50 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
 1-51 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 1-52 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 1-53 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
