BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Section 466.015, Government Code, is amended by amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (b-2) to read as follows:

- (b) The commission shall adopt rules to the extent they are not inconsistent with Chapters 551 and 552 governing the:
- (1) security for the lottery and the commission, including the development of an internal security plan;
- (2) apportionment of the total revenues from the sale of tickets and from all other sources in the amounts provided by this chapter;
- (3)enforcement of prohibitions on the sale of tickets to or by an individual younger than 18 years of age; and
- (4) enforcement of prohibitions on a person playing or facilitating the playing of a lottery game by telephone or through the Internet.

- For purposes of this section, a person:

 (1) plays a lottery game by telephone or through the if the person, by telephone or through an Internet application or mobile Internet application:
 - (A) orders or purchases a ticket for the game; or to purchase

(B) arranges for another person ticket on behalf of the person playing the game; and

- facilitates the playing of a lottery bу game telephone or through the Internet if the person, by telephone or through an Internet application or mobile Internet application:
 - (A) accepts orders for or sells a ticket for
