 1-16 AN ACT

1-17 relating to rules permitting service dogs in the Capitol.
 1-18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
 1-19 SECTION 1. Section 443.018(b), Government Code, is amended
 1-20 to read as follows:
 1-21 (b) The rules adopted under Subsection (a) shall include
 1-22 rules that:
 1-23 (1) prohibit persons from attaching signs, banners, or
 1-24 other displays to a part of the Capitol or to a structure, including
 1-25 a fence, on the grounds of the Capitol except as approved by the
 1-26 board;
 1-27 (2) prohibit a visitor from placing furniture in the
 1-28 Capitol or on the grounds of the Capitol for a period that exceeds
 1-29 24 hours except as approved by the board;
 1-30 (3) prohibit the setting up or placement of camping
 1-31 equipment, shelter, or related materials in the Capitol or on the
 1-32 grounds of the Capitol except as approved by the board;
 1-33 (4) prohibit actions that block ingress and egress:
 1-34 (A) into the Capitol building; or
 1-35 (B) rooms or hallways within the Capitol
 1-36 building, except as approved by the board;
 1-37 (5) prohibit actions that pose a risk to safety;
 1-38 (6) provide that members of the public must leave the
 1-39 Capitol when the building is closed to the public;
 1-40 (7) provide that all pets except service [~~Seeing Eye~~]
 1-41 dogs are not permitted in the Capitol, and shall be restrained at
 1-42 all times on a leash or similar device in the immediate control of
 1-43 the owner while on the grounds of the Capitol, except as approved by
 1-44 the board;
 1-45 (8) prohibit the use of skateboards, rollerblades, and
 1-46 rollerskates in the Capitol or on the grounds of the Capitol; and
 1-47 (9) prohibit a vendor or commercial enterprise from
 1-48 operating in the Capitol or on the grounds of the Capitol unless the
 1-49 vendor or commercial enterprise is authorized to do so by the board.
 1-50 SECTION 2. As soon as practicable after the effective date
 1-51 of this Act, the State Preservation Board shall update the rules
 1-52 required by Section 443.018, Government Code, as amended by this
 1-53 Act.
 1-54 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
