HB 4078 Geren

Relating to motor vehicle franchised dealers and the reimbursement of motor vehicle franchised dealers by manufacturers and distributors for warranty, recall, and preparation and delivery work.

HB 3545 Moody

Relating to civil liability arising from a firearm hold agreement.

HB 4557 Darby / Leach / Bonnen / Guillen / Landgraf / et al. Relating to liability for capturing and storing carbon dioxide.

HB 3443 Canales / Cook / Capriglione / Noble / Morales, Eddie Relating to adding a designation on a person's driver's license or commercial driver's license indicating that the person is licensed to carry a handgun.

HB 3026 Oliverson

Relating to the administration of a prescription drug manufacturer or third-party prescription assistance program.

HB 3771 Johnson, Julie / Button / Buckley / Rose / Morrison / et al.

Relating to the creation of the employer child-care contribution partnership program administered by the Texas Workforce Commission; authorizing a civil penalty.

HB 4419 Goldman / Ashby / Hunter / Morrison / Collier / et al. Relating to the promotion of film and television production in this state, including the eligibility of film or television productions for funding under the major events reimbursement program, the creation of a film events trust fund and a film production tax rebate trust fund, the establishment of virtual film production institutes, and the designation of media production development zones.

HB 5005 Cook / Smith / Geren / Anchía / Turner Relating to the disclosure under the public information law of a motor vehicle license plate number captured in a video recording maintained by a law enforcement agency.

HB 2684 Burns

Relating to the issuance of oversize or overweight permits for vehicles transporting agricultural commodities during or preceding a disaster.

HB 3039 Klick

Relating to the Dentist and Dental Hygienist Compact; authorizing fees.

HB 2181 Rose

Relating to the administration by the Texas Department of Housing and Community Affairs of a homeless housing and services program for youth and young adults.

HB 2542 Raymond

Relating to the adoption of uniform rules for hours of work for certain county employees.

HB 2779 Leach

Relating to the compensation of a district judge and the associated retirement benefits of certain other elected state officials.

HB 1775 Thompson, Ed

Relating to the oversight and election of board members for certain emergency services districts.

HB 1696 Buckley / Oliverson / Cook / Gerdes / Noble / et al. Relating to the relationship between managed care plans and optometrists and therapeutic optometrists.

HB 1460 Guillen

Relating to axle weight limitations for certain vehicles transporting aggregates.

HB 1457 Rosenthal / Wilson / Garcia / Cortez
Relating to required military informed care or military cultural competency
training for certain personnel of entities that provide mental health
services to veterans or veterans' families before award of a state agency
grant.

Relating to the creation of a pretrial intervention program for certain youth offenders; authorizing a fee.

HB 2553 Stucky / Swanson

Relating to the treatment of a patient by a physical therapist without a referral.

HB 4181 Muñoz, Jr.

Relating to an exemption from ad valorem taxation of the residence homestead of the surviving spouse of a military service member who is killed or fatally injured in the line of duty.

HB 3485 Bell, Keith / Leach / Patterson / Cook Relating to a contractor's or subcontractor's right to elect not to proceed with additional work under a contract.

HB 3599 Thierry

Relating to an exemption from certain motor fuel taxes for, and registration fees for motor vehicles owned by, certain nonprofit food banks.

HB 2541 Garcia / Campos / Johnson, Julie / Sherman, Sr. / Oliverson

Relating to policies and procedures regarding children placed by the Department of Family and Protective Services in a residential treatment center or program.
