Relating to disclosure under the public information law of information related to a competitive matter involving the provision of cable, Internet, or broadband services by a public power utility.

SB 1075 King

Relating to facilities and construction machinery used to respond to power outages.

SB 1111 Schwertner

Relating to transmission and distribution system resiliency planning by and cost recovery for electric utilities.

SB 1170 Perry

Relating to the initiation of customer choice by municipally owned utilities that provide electric service.

SB 1219 Kolkhorst

Relating to the confidentiality of fraud detection and deterrence and counterterrorism information under the public information law.

Relating to the advertising of certain used motor vehicles.
