BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Section 193.006, Health and Safety Code, is amended by amending Subsection (d) and adding Subsection (e) to read as follows:

- (d) When the death certificate of a person to which this section applies is filed with the vital statistics unit, the department [state registrar] shall submit to [notify] the Texas Veterans Commission deidentified information on the person's:
- or homicide; (1) manner of death, only if the death was by suicide

age;

- (3) race;
- previous use of psychotropic drugs, only if that (4) information is reasonably available to the department;

(5) sex; and

- (6) occupation.
- later than December 1 of each year, Not Veterans Commission shall prepare and submit to the standing committees of the legislature with primary jurisdiction over veterans affairs and publish on the commission's Internet website a written report that contains:

 (1) aggregated data based on the information the
- commission receives under Subsection (d) for the preceding year;
 - (2) an evaluation of that data; and
