1-20 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-21 AN ACT

1-22 relating to the authority of a property owners' association to
1-23 assess a fine for discolored vegetation or turf during a period of
1-24 residential watering restriction.

1-25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-26 SECTION 1. Chapter 202, Property Code, is amended by adding
1-27 Section 202.008 to read as follows:

1-28 Sec. 202.008. LIMITATION ON FINES DURING RESIDENTIAL WATER
1-29 RESTRICTION. (a) For the purposes of this section, "residential
1-30 watering restriction" means a temporary restriction of water use to
1-31 irrigate residential vegetation or turf that is mandated by a
1-32 municipality, water utility, or other wholesale or retail water
1-33 supplier as part of a strategy to conserve water during a period of
1-34 drought.

1-35 (b) A property owners' association may not assess a fine
1-36 against a property owner for a violation of an applicable
1-37 restrictive covenant that requires the owner to plant or install
1-38 grass or turf or maintain green vegetation or turf or prohibits
1-39 discolored or brown vegetation or turf on the property:

1-40 (1) during a period when the owner's property is
1-41 subject to a residential watering restriction under which
1-42 discolored or brown vegetation or turf could reasonably result; and

1-43 (2) before the 60th day after the date a residential
1-44 watering restriction described by Subdivision (1) is lifted.

1-45 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.

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
