(d) This state, acting as authorized under federal law, shall observe daylight saving time year-round. This subsection applies to both the portion of this state using central standard time as the official standard time and the portion of this state 1-25 1-26 1-27 1-28 using mountain standard time as the official standard time. 1-29 The standard time in this state shall be referred to as Texas Time. 1-30
