1-21 relating to daylight saving time.  
1-22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:  
1-23 SECTION 1. Section 312.016, Government Code, is amended by  
1-24 adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:  
1-25 (d) This state, acting as authorized under federal law,  
1-26 shall observe daylight saving time year-round. This subsection  
1-27 applies to both the portion of this state using central standard  
1-28 time as the official standard time and the portion of this state  
1-29 using mountain standard time as the official standard time. The  
1-30 standard time in this state shall be referred to as Texas Time.  
1-31 SECTION 2. (a) Except as otherwise provided by this  
1-32 section, this Act takes effect September 1, 2025.  
1-33 (b) This Act takes effect only if the United States Congress  
1-34 enacts legislation that becomes law that authorizes the State of  
1-35 Texas to observe daylight saving time year-round. If the United  
1-36 States Congress does not enact legislation that becomes law  
1-37 described by this subsection, this Act has no effect.
