1-17 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to a study on the increased incidence of cancer in female
1-20 firefighters in this state.

1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. (a) In this Act:

1-23 (1) "Commission" means the Texas Commission on Fire
1-24 Protection.

1-25 (2) "Department" means the Department of State Health
1-26 Services.

1-27 (3) "Registry" means the cancer registry established
1-28 under Chapter [82](#), Health and Safety Code.

1-29 (b) The department, in collaboration with the commission
1-30 and using registry information, shall conduct a study on the
1-31 increased incidence of cancer in female firefighters in this state.

1-32 (c) In conducting the study, the department and commission
1-33 shall, using registry information and data collected from readily
1-34 available sources, compare cancer rates among female firefighters
1-35 in this state to cancer rates among other women, focusing on cancers
1-36 specific to women, including ovarian and breast cancer.

1-37 (d) Not later than September 1, 2026:

1-38 (1) the department shall prepare and submit to the
1-39 legislature a written report containing the results of the study
1-40 and any recommendations for legislative or other action; and

1-41 (2) the department and commission shall make the
1-42 report publicly available by posting the report on the agencies'
1-43 and registry's respective Internet websites.

1-44 (e) This Act expires September 1, 2027.

1-45 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
