1-20 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-21 AN ACT

1-22 relating to the required age for a license or permit relating to the
1-23 conduct of a public fireworks display.

1-24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-25 SECTION 1. Section 2154.101(b), Occupations Code, is
1-26 amended to read as follows:

1-27 (b) A person who is younger than 18 [21] years of age may not
1-28 be issued a [pyrotechnic operator's license. The minimum age of a
1-29 person issued another] license under Subchapter D [is 18 years of
1-30 age].

1-31 SECTION 2. Section 2154.201(a), Occupations Code, is
1-32 amended to read as follows:

1-33 (a) [A person who is younger than 21 years of age may not be
1-34 issued a public fireworks display permit.] A person who is younger
1-35 than 18 years of age may not be issued a [another] permit under this
1-36 subchapter.

1-37 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
