1-20 relating to regulation by certain counties of roadside or parking
 1-21 lot vendors and solicitors.

1-22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-23 SECTION 1. Section 285.001(a), Transportation Code, is
 1-24 amended to read as follows:

1-25 (a) To promote the public safety, the commissioners court of
 1-26 a county with a population of more than 1.3 million and a county
 1-27 with a population of more than 600,000 that is adjacent to a county
 1-28 with a population of more than four million by order may regulate
 1-29 the following in the unincorporated area of the county if they occur
 1-30 on a public highway or road, in the right-of-way of a public highway
 1-31 or road, or in a parking lot:

1-32 (1) the sale of items by a vendor of food or
 1-33 merchandise, including live animals;

1-34 (2) the erection, maintenance, or placement of a
 1-35 structure by a vendor of food or merchandise, including live
 1-36 animals; and

1-37 (3) the solicitation of money.

1-38 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.

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
