1-17 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to the designation of a portion of State Highway 34 in
1-20 Kaufman County as the Officer Jacob Candanoza Memorial Highway.

1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 225, Transportation Code,
1-23 is amended by adding Section 225.249 to read as follows:

1-24 Sec. 225.249. OFFICER JACOB CANDANOZA MEMORIAL HIGHWAY.

1-25 (a) The portion of State Highway 34 in Kaufman County between its
1-26 intersection with Kings Creek Drive and its intersection with North
1-27 Frances Street is designated as the Officer Jacob Candanoza
1-28 Memorial Highway. The designation is in addition to any other
1-29 designation.

1-30 (b) Subject to Section 225.021(c), the department shall:

1-31 (1) design and construct markers indicating the
1-32 designation as the Officer Jacob Candanoza Memorial Highway and any
1-33 other appropriate information; and

1-34 (2) erect a marker at each end of the highway and at
1-35 appropriate intermediate sites along the highway.

1-36 SECTION 2. It is the intention of the 89th Legislature,
1-37 Regular Session, 2025, that the provisions added by this Act be
1-38 renumbered to prevent multiple provisions with the same
1-39 designation.

1-40 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
