1-16 AN ACT

1-17 relating to the disclosure or release of certain information  
1-18 received by the attorney general regarding an application for  
1-19 compensation from the crime victims' compensation fund.

1-20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-21 SECTION 1. Article 56B.058(b), Code of Criminal Procedure,  
1-22 is amended to read as follows:

1-23 (b) An application for compensation under this chapter and  
1-24 any information, document, summary, or other record provided to or  
1-25 received, maintained, or created by the attorney general under this  
1-26 chapter, including a report released to the attorney general under  
1-27 Article 56B.054(f), is:

1-28 (1) except as provided by Section 552.132(c),  
1-29 Government Code, not subject to disclosure under Chapter 552 of  
1-30 that code; and

1-31 (2) except as provided by Subsection (c), not subject  
1-32 to disclosure, discovery, subpoena, or other means of legal  
1-33 compulsion for release.

1-34 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
