1-17 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to assisted living facility operations and provision of  
1-20 certain services to assisted living facility residents without a  
1-21 license; creating a criminal offense.

1-22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-23 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 142, Health and Safety  
1-24 Code, is amended by adding Section 142.00605 to read as follows:

1-25 Sec. 142.00605. PERSONAL ASSISTANCE SERVICES PROVIDED  
1-26 WITHOUT LICENSE TO CERTAIN INDIVIDUALS; CRIMINAL OFFENSE. (a) A  
1-27 person commits an offense if the person:

1-28 (1) is required to hold a license under this chapter;  
1-29 and

1-30 (2) provides without holding the required license  
1-31 personal assistance services to a resident of an assisted living  
1-32 facility, as defined by Section 247.002.

1-33 (b) An offense under this section is a Class A misdemeanor,  
1-34 except the offense is a felony of the third degree if the person has  
1-35 been previously convicted of an offense under this section.

1-36 SECTION 2. Subchapter C, Chapter 247, Health and Safety  
1-37 Code, is amended by adding Section 247.0441 to read as follows:

1-38 Sec. 247.0441. LICENSE REQUIRED; CRIMINAL PENALTY. (a) A  
1-39 person commits an offense if the person operates an assisted living  
1-40 facility without holding a license issued under this chapter.

1-41 (b) An offense under this section is a Class A misdemeanor,  
1-42 except the offense is a felony of the third degree if the person has  
1-43 been previously convicted of an offense under this section.

1-44 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
